

## 2024 FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

## **Fellowship Program Details**

- If selected for the UAW Fellowship, you will participate in an intensive leadership training program with members from across our union. This work-study program will prepare you to assist UAW teaching staff in conducting discussions and workshops at the local and regional levels, as well as at the Family Scholarship program.
- Participants must be a member in good standing, an active role with their employer.
- Fellows will be expected to fully participate in the 31-day program, consisting of three touchpoints over a span of six months. This program requires a serious commitment to complete assignments at home, in addition to attending and fully participating in the following:
  - > Touchpoint 1: February 11-16, 2024, in Detroit, Michigan
  - > Touchpoint 2: April 7-13, 2024, at the UAW Family Education Center in Onaway, Michigan
  - Touchpoint 3 April 14-19, 2024, at the Education Committee Conference (attend as a delegate and provide instructor support)
  - Touchpoint 4:July 14-20, 2024, at the UAW Family Education Center in Onaway, Michigan
  - ➤ Touchpoint 5 July 21-26, 2024, at the Family Scholarship Program (facilitate workshops and activities)

It is required that Fellows be present during the dates above, including weekends.

- If selected for the Fellowship, you will receive an informational packet with all the details in January 2024.
- Per our guidelines, payment is on a non-lost time basis. Participants receive \$1000 for the week. Mileage is reimbursed at the IRS rate for each mile or coach fare, whichever is less. Per diem allowance is \$55 per day and \$25 for the travel day. Per diem is not provided when the UAW provides meals. If possible, arrangements should be made for the participant to be paid through the local union. The local union will be reimbursed by the International Union upon submission of bills covering allowable expenses. Payment requests must be submitted within 30 days after the touchpoint is held to UAW Education Department, 8000 E. Jefferson Ave., Detroit, MI 48214, ATTN: Susan Pratt. If you have any questions, Susan may be reached at (313) 926-8027.
- If needed, the UAW will also cover insurance costs.
- If you reside more than 500 miles from your destination (Detroit and the UAW Family Education Center), you may opt to fly. All flight arrangements will be made by the UAW Family Education Center. Depending upon room availability, Fellows may be housed on a double-occupancy basis.

#### Family Scholarship Details

- If selected for the Fellowship, you will spend the last five days of the program teaching at the 2024 Family Scholarship Program.
- Eligible immediate family members of the Fellows will be allowed to participate in the July 21-26, 2024, Family Scholarship session. Family members include spouses, children, and grandchildren ages 4 through 18. Parents, nieces, or nephews are not eligible to attend unless you are the legal guardian and can provide the proper paperwork. There will be no cost to your family to attend the scholarship program. If you reside more than 500 miles (one-way) from the Center, your family's transportation costs will be paid by the UAW.

- You will be paid \$1000 weekly, plus room, board, and transportation. You will also receive an allowance for any
  meals that are not provided by the UAW when the Center's Dining Room is closed. If needed, the UAW will also
  cover insurance costs.
- All fellows participating in Family Scholarship are required to submit to a background check, as you may be working with children.
