
It has just been brought to our attention that the State of Michigan's requirement of reporting the Performance Bonus has changed.

Please be advised, with the upcoming Performance Award Payment being paid out on June 10, 2022 (tomorrow), the new directive in reporting the bonus is as followed.

Employees on Layoff

Employees on layoff and receiving a Performance Award must report these earnings to their State Unemployment Agencies as follows:

- Illinois, Indiana, and Ohio – Do not report the Performance Award payment as earnings.
- Michigan – Do not report the Performance Award payment as earnings.
- For all other States, please refer to your State for reporting requirements.

We know that this notification is late and there maybe be some members who will follow the first directive in reporting the bonus payment. If they do so, the original process remains the same. It will not preclude them from their eligibility for SUB. SUB will be paid based on the SSB payment amount from the State.
