

The white masks:

- The mask does not come in a consistent size.(either too small or too bigger) The plant found rare instances when the strings were not the same size, employees are encouraged to exchange their mask if they encounter any quality issues. The supervisor is to notify the safety department for appropriate follow up. This issue has been discussed with the manufacturer Comau. Please retain examples.
- the mask do not stay on the nose (when member talk the mask don't stay on) The plant has mask extenders that may be used to adjust the fit so the mask stays on the nose. Employees may request the mask extender from their supervisor or safety department. (see picture of a similar extender below)
- the metal piece in the middle with not stay tight (you fold it and it doesn't stay in place) which also require you to touch your face all day. The plant has not found this issue, nor had it come up in the daily task force meetings but again if there are any issues with the metal piece, employees are encouraged to exchange the mask. Safety department should also be notified if employees find quality issues with the metal nose piece and provide examples.
- The mask are very thin. The masks meet ASTM F2100 Level 1 requirements for both bacterial and sub-micron particle efficiency, two important parameters for protection from spread of disease. The white masks are made in the United States.

In addition, SSP conducted safety stand downs last week to reinforce compliance including disciplining individuals that were still not following PPE safety requirements.
