# **Updated COVID-19 Protocols**

In alignment with the 3-Company COVID-19 Task Force (Stellantis, Ford, and GM) direction and in agreement with the UAW leadership, effective today the following changes are implemented in the COVID-19 Protocols for **US locations ONLY:** 

## **Face Masks:**

- Face masks are now voluntary for Stellantis employees, contractors and visitors at facilities located within the United States unless superseded by local legislative requirements.
- Regardless of site requirements, company-issued **face masks are required** to be worn prior to entering Stellantis Medical Departments.
- Company face masks will still remain available for some period of time for voluntary use.

## **Contact Tracing:**

• COVID-19 contact tracing will no longer be required or take place.

#### **COVID-19 Protocols:**

 Other COVID-19 Protocols are being reviewed for changes and will be communicated.

#### **COVID-19 Vaccination:**

 Vaccination is the leading public health prevention strategy to prevent severe disease and deaths from COVID-19. Stellantis strongly encourages all employees to get vaccinated and to stay up to date with the recommended booster shots following Public Health guidance and direction.
